8. Reports from the Nordic countries:

a. Norway

Randonneurs Norway has had 156 approved brevets during the year 2019

b. Denmark

The number of approved brevets the last eight years has been constant with a slight decrease PBP years. 2019 Denmark had 638 approved brevets. The recruitment of new Randonneurs is a problem. A good initiative is a senior brevets 100 km with good results.

d. Sweden

The number of riders is increasing in Sweden, and what we see as a success factor is spreading the message from mouth to mouth method. Also race reports on various websites and magazines have contributed to the success. In 2019 Sweden has had 1200 approved brevets, a slight decrease compared to the previous year and we suspect it is due to PBP.





9. Paris-Brest-Paris 2019, Comments on this year's edition:

It seems that cyclists are poorly prepared for the task in Paris, with bicycles that are not adapted for Randonneés. Comments have also been made regarding the starting cards regarding the minimum - maximum time on intermediate controls. If the cyclists followed minimum - maximum that were indicated on the card then they would have ended up finishing outside their maximum time. New for this year was the app (Chrono Course) where you could easily follow the bikers. Much appreciated

10. Flèche Nordique 2020:

11. Super Brevet Scandinavia 2021

The planning has already started for the SBS 2021. The concept will be as the 2017-edition. A maximum of 100 entries. A new web site will be made containing online entry and payment. In the 2013 and 2017 editions, the crew have had problems doing both controls and transportation. There is a need for local randonneurs providing assistance on the controls and helping riders coming late to the accommodations. In Sweden this need is especially felt for Brålanda where several officials are needed.

The need for staff at the control places also applies in Norway

The work to get a coordinator for the event will be completed in December 2019.

12. Length of Sweden, Sverigetempot:

The planning has already started for the Length of Sweden Sverigetempot. Pre-registration has been opened and was fully subscribed in 10 days with 200 participants. 4 - 5 people are involved in the work with the race and the 2020 edition will be the 6th edition of Length of Sweden Sverigetempot.

In the pre-registration, there are riders from 10 - 15 countries and from almost all continents, only Africa is missing. The race will be held on the 1st week of July 2020.

Due to changed rules (Randonneurs Mondiaux) regarding average speed, the maximum time will be extended from 177 hours to 210 hours.
